Executive Summary

Haslinda Abdullah is currently a Professor of Applied Psychology at the Department of Social and Development Sciences, Faculty of Human Ecology, University Putra Malaysia. She began her academic world at Mara Institute of Technology, Shah Alam Selangor, taking Diploma in Sciences. She then pursues her studies at the International Islamic University, taking Psychology as her main focus (minor in revealed knowledge). Her academic path moved one step forward when she took M.A in Developmental Psychology at National University of Malaysia and finally received her PhD from Institute of Work Health and Organizations, University of Nottingham, United Kingdom, specializing in Applied Psychology. Since May 2000, she has taught various subjects and key areas of Psychology, including Social Psychology, Theories in Social Psychology, Community Psychology, and Psychology of Work.

She actively participates as speaker as well as paper presenter in various National and international seminars, conferences, and intellectual discourses. She has presented papers in the United States, Copenhagen, Denmark, United Kingdom, Portugal, Turkey, Korea, Thailand, and Philippines. She has also moderated several sessions of discussion in international conferences.

Her book with Associate Professor Dr Ma'rof Redzuan on Psychology is one of her major contributions in her area and is now on its third edition. The book has been widely used in

other academic institutions since it is in Bahasa Melayu. Her interests include Islam and Psychology which she, together with Professor Dr. Zaid Ahmad is now exploring and try to promote the idea of Psycho spiritual in transforming the behavior of human being. Her writings on this issue can be seen in conferences as well as chapters in books. Issues such as climate and altitude in determining human behavior also has become her interest lately and can be seen in a paper presented at University of Malaya entitled *Pengaruh Iklim Terhadap Sifat Manusia: Suatu Catatan dari Muqaddimah Ibn Khaldun dalam Ibn Khaldun: Pemikiran Ibn Khaldun & Relevansinya Dalam Tamadun Kontemporari*.

Currently her works are more focused on youth and development. Her credentials and knowledge on the Malaysian youth is reflected in her role as a member of the think tank for the Institute for Youth Research Malaysia (IYRES), a statutory body acting as the National youth development research center under Ministry of Youth and Sports. Moreover, her position as an expert committee member on revising the current Malaysian Youth Act, and as the appointee of the Majlis Professor Negara pertaining to youth allows her voice to have a direct say in shaping a new Malaysia. Her research in this area is extensive and her recent partnership, which focuses on sexual and reproductive health, was with the Bronfenbrenner Center for Translational Research, Cornell University, as a visiting scholar in 2017.

With her broad experience regarding research on youth, Permata Negara has invited her to speak on the topic of Youth entitled 'Youth: Failure is not an option'. She was also an invited speaker for 'Projek Amanat Negara XVI 2019', by United Kingdom and Eire Council for Malaysian Students (UKEC) to talk on the future of Malaysian children. Under a Muslim women NGO (MPWIM), she was appointed to lead a panel of experts to select future youth leaders. Outside of the academic field, she is the president of Family Empowerment Society (FAME), an NGO that strives to tackle societal issues (regarding family) head-on.

She has actively developed training modules for several agencies, such as the Department of National Unity, the Institute of Social Malaysia (ISM) and the Malaysian Prison Department. She is also a trainer for the Malaysian Technical Cooperation Program (MTCP), in which she trained a group of prison officers from a Commonwealth country on youth. Her contribution was acknowledged by the Malaysian Prison Department when she was given Pingat Bakti Setia in 2015.
